The Web Developer is responsible for the development and maintenance of custom-built web applications to support RSR Group's growing E-commerce business, in addition to bridging our current back-end infrastructure with new front-end web services. This position works with the various business units to define user interfaces and requirements. Responsibilities could include all aspects of the Software Development Life Cycle (SDLC) including analysis, design, testing, and integration and deployment to ensure quality products are delivered.

Integrate data from various back-end services and databases operating on Linux Red Hat system.

Cooperate with web designers to match visual design intent.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Strong experience with python (Django/Django Rest Framework preferred) and PHP.
- Experience with JavaScript, including jQuery. React experience is a plus.
- Strong knowledge of relational databases such as MySQL, SQL and schema design.
- Experience with mobile development, including iOS and Android, is a plus.
- Experience with source control, preferably Git, and issue tracking systems like Jira.
- Strong experience in designing and implementing architectures and solutions for robust, secure and scalable web applications.
- Aggressive problem-diagnosis and creative problem-solving skills.
- Strong organizational skills to juggle multiple tasks within the constraints of timelines and budgets with business acumen.
